

2016 FLOOD LINE PINOT NOIR

The 2016 Flood Line is from the Valin-Morrissey vineyard, which consists of two blocks — lower (Valin) and upper (Morrissey). Originally a land lease, Rex Hill Vineyards paid to develop this property. Years later when they started cutting away properties, Valin-Morrissey was the last on the chopping block. We thought it was crazy to let such an incredible site go and pounced on it, farming it collaboratively and sustainably. Yields wines of classic Eola-Amity Hills character: cola, tobacco, cherries and cardamom all day long.



"Aromas of ripe red berries and cherry, along with subtle cola and licorice nuances. Sweet and penetrating on the palate, offering bitter cherry and raspberry flavors that flesh out on the back half. A smoky note emerges on the clinging finish, which features fine-grained tannins and suave red fruit preserve and mocha qualities." —Josh Raynolds
