VIATGE AL PRIORAT 2012

90 points


“Spicy red berries and fresh flowers on the nose, with a zesty mineral quality adding vibrancy and lift. Bitter cherry, licorice and violet pastille flavors show very good clarity and put on weight with air, picking up a note of five-spice powder with air. Closes sappy and long, with smooth tannins coming in late.”



SENTIUS 2009

91 points

“Sexy black and blue fruit aromas are complicated by smoky mineral and cola qualities. Fleshy cassis and blueberry flavors are sharpened and lifted by juicy acidity. Gains sweetness and depth with air, finishing with a suave note of black raspberry and silky, polished tannins.”



LES ERES 2009

93 points

“Nuanced spicy aromas of cassis, black raspberry, violet, orange zest and smoky minerals. Juicy and bright on the palate, offering dark berry, floral pastille and bitter chocolate flavors lifted by a zesty mineral element. Dense and fleshy but structured, with tangy acidity lifting the strikingly long, gently tannic finish.”
