



2019 BOIS JOLI PINOT NOIR

Owned by former forestry professor Barbara Bond and her architect partner Rob Kistler, Bois Joli is an uber-sustainably farmed vineyard perched high up on the West (Amity) side of the Eola-Amity Hills. This property, where you will often find sheep wandering the vineyard rows, among the lumbering live oaks (300+ years old), and Douglas fir forest, offers a delicateness that we don't see in our other sites in this region - perfumed and lithe, supremely elegant.
