BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Mestizaje Blanco 2024 || 91 points

“The 2024 Mestizaje from Valencia opens with floral and white fruit aromas, including hints of apple, pear and subtle herbs. Medium-bodied and fresh, the palate balances fruit with light grip and a saline edge. The Xarel-lo was macerated on skins. A flavorful white, well judged in its texture.”



BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Finca Calvestra 2023 || 93 points

“The 2023 Merseguera Finca Calvestra from Valencia (Vino de España), partly aged in acacia barrels, opens with Mediterranean notes of herbs, fennel and green tea alongside pear and subtle oak, with caramel and vanilla nuances. Slightly concentrated yet fresh, it shows a smooth texture and energy on the palate, lifted by delicate oak.”



BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Finca Calvestra Las Margas 2020 || 96 points

“The 2023 Merseguera Finca Calvestra from Valencia (Vino de España), partly aged in acacia barrels, opens with Mediterranean notes of herbs, fennel and green tea alongside pear and subtle oak, with caramel and vanilla nuances. Slightly concentrated yet fresh, it shows a smooth texture and energy on the palate, lifted by delicate oak.”



BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Mestizaje Tinto 2022 || 92 points

“The 2022 Mestizaje from Utiel-Requena, located outside the DO, begins with plum, soft oak and a touch of warmth, later opening to chocolate. On the palate, fine reactive tannins frame a clear fruit character with grip and modern polish. A contemporary red from Valencia classified among the Grandes Vinos de España.”



BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Finca Terrerazo 2022 || 94 points

“The 2022 Finca Terrerazo is a Vino de Pago from Valencia, made from 100% Bobal and was aged two years in foudres. It offers pomegranate, sour cherry, dried flowers and thyme with a light oak note. Agile and taut, the palate has chalky grip and juicy freshness with fine yet reactive tannins. Unlike most Spanish reds, this Bobal is all about finesse and tension rather than weight—the antithesis of Tempranillo.”



BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Quincha Corral 2019 || 94 points

“The 2019 Bobal Quincha Corral is a Vino de Pago from Valencia. Mature and slightly liqueur-like, with notes of elderberry jam, olives, oak and herbs, it shows oak influence at the core of the palate. Dry and juicy with compact tension, it finishes with grip and chalk. A complex, mature-leaning wine reflecting an earlier era in Mustiguillo’s style.”
